**Chaddesley Parish Council Meeting – 1<sup>st</sup> March 2021**

**Local Issues**

We have been dealing with the usual routine casework.

We have the following information regarding the enforcement issues: -

Regarding the enforcement issues for Mr & Mrs Smith's Caravan Site and The Polly Tunnells, they have until 1<sup>st</sup> April.

We have chased the litter picking of the A448 and A450 and this should be done this coming week as WFDC will require traffic management to do this, they have apologised for the delay. We have also reported fly tipping off Sandy Lane near Stanleys Farm for inspection and removal.

**Wyre Forest Issues**

In respect of the WFDC's draft Local Plan, the Public Hearings by the Planning Inspector have concluded and we await the inspector's report.

Wyre Forest House is still closed to the public as is the Green Street Hub save for dealing with housing and homelessness applications.

The Progressive Alliance budget failed to be passed at Full Council on 24<sup>th</sup> February and the Council will reconvene on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> March at 5:30pm to try and reach an agreement.

It is proposed that Council tax is increased by £5 which is the maximum it can be (2% or £5 increase, whichever is the higher) otherwise the local referendum principles apply.
