Mr P Bassett attended the meeting on the understanding that he was unable to give any advice or comments relating to planning due to the Inspection currently taking place on the District Council Local Plan, to which the Parish Council were objectors.

1. Review of Grid

The first part of the graph covered existing designations.

The second part of the graph was new proposals for inclusion in the Revised NP. Protected Views were cross referenced where appropriate'

A discussion took place on the size of a site which varied considerably. Clarification was needed on whether it was necessary to obtain landowners permission before including a site.

2. Review of Conservation Area

PB explained how the original maps were produced and that any changes would need to be agreed and approved by the District Council. Presumably the adoption of a new Neighbourhood Plan would trigger this operation. Changes would need to show boundaries and rationale.

A discussion took place about the extent of the existing Conservation Areas and which properties were included. It was agreed that a new map should be produced showing proposed new boundaries.

3. There was already a map showing new boundaries for the Harvington Conservation Area, which included Harvington Hall Farm and the field next to the Moat.

4. Presentation of Information in Revised NP

An example had been prepared giving a brief description of the site, as well as a Justification Grid and this was agreed and would be prepared for each site. Further information was available from Worcestershire County Council on Ancient Local Listed landmarks and it was felt these should be referenced on the Grid. Photographs of each site were also required.
