- 2. Archaeology DD reported on discussions with Worcestershire Archive & Archaeology Service who could provide searches tailored to our requirements for £200. It was agreed that this would be the best one for our purposes, subject to agreement from the Steering Group.
- 3. Wildlife Corridor DD had received information from Worcestershire County Council Biological Records Centre which would need to be tailored to our particular requirements.
- 4. Review of Sites WM had completed the spreadsheet and each site was scored 1-10. A revised spreadsheet would be sent to members for their comment and a decision taken at what level sites would be excluded as being less important.
- 5. Conservation Area Chaddesley Although no changes were proposed to the map originally included in the CCCA, some of the Important Spaces boundaries were not clearly identified, so a new map would be produced. A discussion took place as to whether there was a need to justify these existing Important Spaces and it was felt unnecessary as they had been included in the CCCA.
- 6. Conservation Area Harvington Historic maps had been provided and compared with the new map showing slight extensions to the Conservation Area, to include the barns from Harvington Hall Farm and the area of the old Quarry and believed Ice House. A new map would be prepared for inclusion in the Revised NP with justification for the proposed changes.
